Activities Inclusion

The Union Notes:

The University of Goldsmiths Students' Union is an organisation which prides itself on being inclusive and representative.

Throughout recent years there has been a substantial decrease in involvement within the Unions Activities.

It is important to recognise the underrepresented areas of the Student body and there has been a call to address this.

The Activities meeting reached a consensus that it is imperative to have Activities represented at a Sabbatical level.

The Union Believes:

To be a fully representative organisation the Union must take seriously the consensus from the Activities meeting.

If we are to be a stronger and far more engaged Union, Activities must be represented at a Sabbatical level to ensure the issues are addressed.

The change will be for representation purposes only and will not be an administrative role.

The Union Resolves:

The Sabbatical Campaigns Officers' title will be changed to be known as 'Campaigns and Activities'

The remit will explicitly say that the post is to 'Represent the Activities and not to be an Administrative role'

A new working group will be created for this new post which will incorporate the Sports Officer, Societies Officer and the Volunteers Officer.
